BACHELOR OF ARTS IN ENGLISH: CONCENTRATION IN LITERATURE – ENGL ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT) ROADMAP

This is a sample pathway for students who transfer to San Francisco State University in the current Bulletin year with an AA-T in English. Six lowerdivision units in the major (ENG 218 and ENG 250) and all lower-division GE requirements have been satisfied. Additional units in the major may have been satisfied. To Do at SF State:

Enough total units to reach 120 minimum for graduation; 30 units minimum at the upper-division level; to include the following:

- Upper-Division GE Areas B, C, and D (9 units): Courses required for the major may double-count if approved for UD GE.

- Complementary Studies: Consult with a department advisor on how transfer units and/or SF State units can be applied to ensure degree completion within 60 units.
